2025 SMX Next World All-Stars Supplemental Rules



SMX Next World All-Stars Schedule:

September 6: SMX Next World All Stars Playoff 1: zMax Dragway at Charlotte Motor Speedway – Concord, NC.

September 13: SMX Next World All Stars Final: The Dome at America's Center – St. Louis, MO.

Rules:

- In addition to these SMX Next World All-Stars supplemental rules all racing is governed by the 2025 AMA Racing Rulebook except for race rules and procedures which will be governed by the 2025 Supermotocross World Championship Rulebook.
- SMX Next World All-Stars Class
 Displacement: 250cc 4-Stroke
 Age (14+) A & B classified riders only.
 Modified machines permitted.

Registration:

- Online registration is required. Invited riders will receive an invitation email with a registration link; Registration must be completed prior to the expiration of the link.
- Event On-Site registration is required. Although pre-entered, riders must check-in at Industry Services to complete their registration.
- Photo ID may be required at event registration.
- The registration fee is \$200 per class and includes a Rider Pass (includes paddock access, industry seating if available & track access at designated times.

AMA Membership:

• AMA membership is required to compete; Proof of membership must be presented at registration upon request.

Medical Insurance:

• Medical insurance is required to compete; Proof of coverage must be presented at registration upon request.

Concussion Test:

 Completion of the ImPACT neurocognitive baseline test dated within two years of the date of competition is required to compete. Proof of completion must be presented at registration upon request

Eligibility:

- SMX Next World All-Stars:
 - Top 5 finishing racers from **250 Pro Sport** (Class 2) at the 2025 AMA Amateur National Motocross Championship at Loretta Lynns.
 - Top 5 finishing racers from 250 B (Class 4) at the 2025 AMA Amateur National Motocross Championship at Loretta Lynns.
 - Top 5 finishing racers from the SMX Next class at the 2025 AMA SMX Next -Supercross National Championship in Pittsburgh PA.
 - Top 3 finishing racers from the 2025 SMX Next Moto Combine events at Hangtown, Red Bud & Ironman.
 - All qualified racers must remain eligible throughout the day of the event to compete.
- The remaining competitors will be invitational, based on results from major events worldwide.

Non-Eligibility:

- The following professional licensed racers (Pro Motocross or Pro Supercross) are **NOT** eligible to participate in the SMX Next World All-Stars Class:
 - Racers competing in the Final 40 in Pro Motocross (250 or 450 class) in more than three Pro Motocross events per year in the current or previous year;
 - Racers competing in the Final 40 in Pro Supercross (250SX or 450SX class) in the current or previous year; or
 - Racers competing in the Final 40 in an FIM MXGP or MX2 Grand Prix event outside of the United States in the current or previous year.

Technical Inspection:

- Motorcycles must be presented at Technical Inspection.
- Frame numbers will be assigned by the AMA at Technical Inspection.
- Transponders will be provided at Technical Inspection. Failure to return the transponder will result in a charge of \$400. Transponder holders will be available for purchase at Technical Inspection for \$10.
- The official SMX Next World All-Stars logo must appear on the front number plate. Organizer will provide the front number plate decal, or you may download online <u>HERE</u>
- Numbers must be **Hi-Vis Purple** Color Code = (PMS 2090 C) on **White Background**.

Race Program:

- The Race Program will consist of:
 - (2) Free Practice Sessions on Friday at 10 minutes each.
 - (2) Timed Qualifying Sessions on Saturday for qualification & gate selection at (10) minutes each.
 - \circ (1) Main Event at 8 minutes + (1) Lap.
- Maximum (22) riders will compete in the Main Event.

Points:

- Playoff 1 will award single points.
- Final will award double points.
- Points are in accordance to the SMX Playoff 1 & Playoff 2 points scale.
- The rider with the most points following the Finals will be considered the SMX Next World All-Stars Champion.
- Ties are broken according to the better placement in the final event.

Awards:

• Top 3 Finishers will receive awards and podium interviews.

Mechanics:

- One Mechanic per rider permitted on the Start Line.
- Mechanics must purchase a Mechanics Pass regardless of credential status in MX or SX.
- Mechanics Passes provide all-day paddock access, industry seating if available & track access at designated times.
- Mechanics must check-in at Industry Will Call to receive their Mechanics Pass.

Industry Passes:

- Family members and guests may purchase a limited amount of Industry Passes.
- Industry Passes provide all-day paddock access and Industry Seating if available.
- Industry Passes must be picked up at the Industry Services trailer.
