

# 2026 SMX Next World All-Stars Supplemental Rules



## SMX Next World All-Stars Schedule

Playoff 1: September 12: Historic Crew Stadium Columbus, OH.

Final: September 19: Dignity Health Sports Park Los Angeles, CA.

## Rules:

- In addition to these SMX Next World All-Stars supplemental rules all racing is governed by the 2026 AMA Racing Rulebook except for race rules and procedures which will be governed by the 2026 SuperMotocross World Championship Rulebook.
- SMX Next World All-Stars Class  
Displacement: 250cc 4-Stroke  
Age (15+) A & B classified riders only.

## Registration:

- Online registration is required. All SMX Next World All-Stars are required to apply for an SMX Next Race License.
- All pre-entered riders must check-in at Industry Services to complete their registration.
- Photo ID may be required at event registration.
- The registration fee is \$250 and includes the rider pass that allows weekend access to paddock, industry seating if available & track access at designated times.

## AMA Membership:

- AMA membership is required to compete.
- Proof of membership must be presented at registration upon request.

**Medical Insurance:**

- Medical insurance is required to compete; Proof of coverage must be presented at registration upon request.

**Concussion Test:**

- Completion of the ImPACT neurocognitive baseline test dated within two years of the date of competition is required to compete. Proof of completion must be presented at registration upon request.

**Eligibility:**

- Top 5 finishing eligible racers from 250 Pro Sport (Class 2) at the 2026 AMA Amateur National Motocross Championship at Loretta Lynns.
- Top 5 finishing eligible racers from 250 B (Class 4) at the 2026 AMA Amateur National Motocross Championship at Loretta Lynns.
- Top 5 finishing eligible racers from the SMX Next class at the 2026 AMA SMX Next - Supercross National Championship in Philadelphia, PA.
- Top 5 finishing eligible racers from the 2026 SMX Next Moto Combine at Red Bud.
- Top 5 finishing eligible racers from the 2026 SMX Next Moto Combine at Ironman.
- Any remaining competitors will be invitational, based on results from major events worldwide for a total of 25 entrants.
- All qualified racers must remain eligible throughout the day of the event to compete.

**Non-Eligibility:**

The following are **NOT** eligible to participate in the SMX Next World All-Stars Class.

- Racers competing in the Final 40 in Pro Motocross (250 or 450 class) in more than three Pro Motocross events per year in the current or previous year.
- Racers competing in the Final 40 in Pro Supercross (250SX or 450SX class) in the current or previous year.
- Racers competing in the Final 40 in an FIM MXGP or MX2 Grand Prix event outside of the United States in the current or previous year.

**Technical Inspection:**

- Motorcycles must be presented at Technical Inspection.
- Frame numbers will be assigned by the AMA at Technical Inspection.
- Transponders will be provided at Technical Inspection. Failure to return the transponder will result in a charge of \$400. Transponder holders will be available for purchase at Technical Inspection for \$10.
- The official SMX Next World All-Stars logos must appear on the front and side number plates. Organizer will provide the plate decals, or you may download online [HERE](#)
- Numbers must be Hi-Vis Purple Color Code = (PMS 2090 C) on White Background.

**Race Program:**

- (2) Free Practice Sessions on Friday at 10 minutes each.
- (2) Timed Qualifying Sessions on Saturday for qualification & gate selection at (10) minutes each.
- Main Event at 8 minutes + (1) Lap.
- Maximum (22) riders will compete in the Main Event.

**Points:**

- Playoff 1 will be awarded single points in accordance with the SMX Playoff 1 points scale.
- Final will be awarded double points in accordance with the SMX Playoff 2 points scale.
- Ties are broken according to the better placement in the final event.
- The rider with the most points following the Final Event will be considered the SMX Next World All-Stars Champion.

**Mechanics:**

- Mechanics Passes provide all-day paddock access, industry seating if available & track access at designated times. Cost is \$80.
- Mechanics must check-in at Industry Will Call to receive their Mechanics Pass.
- To purchase a Mechanics Pass, contact [pmurphy@feldinc.com](mailto:pmurphy@feldinc.com)
- One Mechanic per rider permitted on the Start Line.
- Mechanics must purchase a Mechanics Pass regardless of credential status in MX or SX.

**Industry Passes:**

- Family members and guests may purchase a limited amount of Industry Passes.
- Industry Passes provide all-day paddock access and Industry Seating if available.
- Industry Passes must be picked up at the Industry Services trailer.
